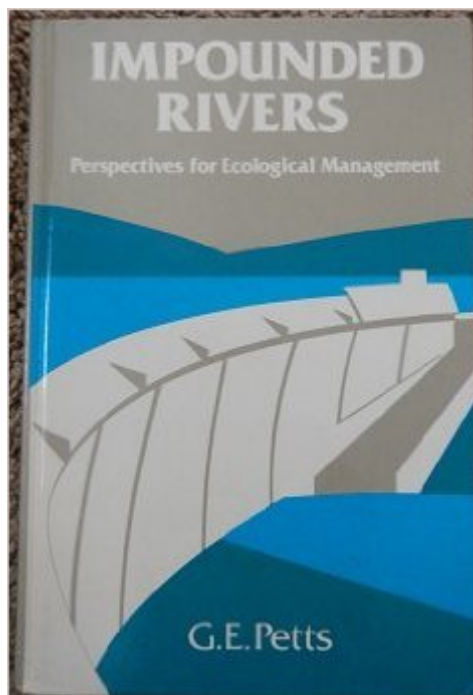


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Impounded Rivers: Perspectives For Ecological Management (Environmental Monographs And Symposia: A Series In Environmental Sciences)
