

I really wanted to get into archery and bowhunting, but as a guy who lives in Philly, it was difficult to catch onto the basics of the sport because not many city-folk sling arrows. I got this book and read it cover-to-cover in two days. Since then, I've re-read it twice. When I finally went to the archery shop and purchased my bow, I was comfortable discussing draw lengths, grain weights, poundage, and everything else pertaining to archery with the salesman. I felt this book helped me make a very

educated purchasing decision and has set me up to be an effective bowhunter when I hit the public lands later this year. If you are interested in archery at all, this book should be your very first purchase. Whether you want to be a target archer or a DIY hunter, you can put yourself on the fast track by purchasing and reading this book.

Change the name to "The Archers Guide to Bows" I would give it 4 stars.

The book is well written and very in depth about bows and their history. I should have looked at the dimensions, because I was not expecting such a large book. I was looking forward to reading this on the stand but its not easily concealable.

I normally don't give much weight to the reviews of other customers, but man-oh-man, those who do

not like this book are spot-on. This is "book" is a combination of two things: a history of archery/introduction for the complete novice, and what basically amounts as an expanded catalog. Readers will get absolutely no pointers on bowhunting, whatsoever. Which, I guess at day's end, is okay since the best teacher is experience, but if one is going to publish a "guide to bowhunting," AT LEAST try to get some "hunting" into the literature.

I'm new to archery and have been trying to read all I can and build good form and habits from the beginning. Fortunately I only spent money on two other books before finding this one. Well written and very informative- And it's easy to read. If you are new to this "sport"- more like meditation for me- do yourself a favor and add this to your collection.

The Guide was very informative but there was a large section of the Guide relating to the Crossbow which I have no interest. The section on the Bow is outstanding. I would give this book a well deserved 5 stars except for the Crossbow section!
