

The journey continues with the MC arriving in "beastland". Cultivation opportunities, physical and otherwise, abound. The MC uses his other-worldly knowledge to assist the beasts...I'll agree with several other reviewers in the need for additional proof reading, and more than a little copy editing. I noted a large block of text that appeared to be copied & pasted -- had to re-read pages of the same thing! There were also quite a number of superfluous words, as if the author changed thought & direction mid-sentence...I would recommend additional study in historical contexts. The handling of the "siege" is both mistaken and erroneous. Additionally, building something like a siege tower and hauling it overland would never happen. Normally, they were built on-site. On other occasions, like

the other mentioned siege equipment, they were broken down for hauling, then assembled on-site. Additionally, even "large iron arrows" into a stone wall 30m thick? Definitely not what they're designed for... The entirety of the battlefield scenes should be re-thought... Finally, best not to "pull things out of the air" -- there was no foreshadowing or allowing for the possibility of the "Blue Phoenix" before it was brought out. All-in-all, the MC does move forward and gains allies, but the writing needs improvement...

Good book worthy of the series but at this moment still in need of a bit of editing and some future improvement on the next one. At about 90% through the book part of one chapter repeats itself, there are a few words that look like they were misinterpreted by autocorrect, and as for the writing style the same concept or caution is repeated over and over AND OVER well past the point of emphasizing and deep into annoying.

The story is in the same style as the previous two parts, but for various reasons I did not enjoy it as much. The story could use the help of an editor or a group of beta readers, especially in regards to superfluous wording and pacing (which was real slow midway). I am not entirely sure I like the powergrowth of the protagonist. He is still being challenged and I can understand the usual path of cultivating is slow and boring to the book, but I hope there is a decent explanation for what is going. Regardless, the world building is good. I do agree with others that I find the absence of interaction with his friends a bit lacking. The new characters all felt a bit flat...

I really enjoyed the journey, and the character development of Hui Yui. Wish some of the side characters from the other books were included kind of like switching between them. But that might be the next book.

This particular volume was much faster than the previous two, and had quite a bit of development of characters that was quite useful. As with the prior volumes, the editing was a bit sloppy. Improve that and it will go a long way towards improving your books as a whole. That said, I am enjoying the story and look forward to seeing the next installment.

If you are reading this posting, then I will say this book is worth the wait. The characters and main character development are awesome. The author writes the story line with great attention to detail, but does not get caught up in over development of details or the characters. I was totally immersed in each of the characters lives and actions within the story. I waiting for the next book, because I can't wait until his friends see how much he developed since the last time together, plus the new Beast nation he help start in the land above.
